Architectural Review Committee "ARC"

ARC has the responsibility for ensuring houses and landscaping are maintained in an attractive manner. ARC utilizes "Architectural Guidelines" from our Covenants to enforce design aspects fairly and consistently. Any changes to the exterior of your home or lot must be approved by ARC before work has begun. Please complete and submit an "ARC Exterior Change Request" form, including specifications, drawings and other information needed by ARC to determine compliance with the guidelines. Trash Containers

We have received complaints that some residents are putting their trash and recycling out the night before Waste Pro pickups instead of early morning the day of pickup. Waste Pro picks up our trash on Tuesday between 8:00 a.m. and late afternoon. This may be inconvenient but it is in keeping with our concerns to maintain a safe environment for our residents. This new rule is under the "Rules and Regulations", under Section H, Garbage Containers. This rule, along with the new rule covering Bird Feeders and Black Bears, was enacted to deny black bears an easy food source in Hadley Park thus discouraging them from roaming in our community and losing their fear of humans.

Aerating Your Lawn

It has come to the HOA's attention that some lawns in Hadley Park have bare and brown patches. It is the responsibility of homeowners to maintain a green lawn and fall is the perfect time for aerating and rejuvenating lawns. Aeration involves perforating the soil with small holes to allow air, water and nutrients to penetrate the grass roots. This helps the roots grow deeply and produce a stronger, more vigorous lawn. The main reason for aerating is to alleviate soil compaction.

Landmark Landscapes offers an aerating service and can give homeowners an estimate of the cost of aerating your lawn. IPM will be in contact with Landmark and will provide more information on this topic via a broadcast email to the Community.
